About Silver Star-1 Exploration Well


The Silver Star-1 well is a high impact exploration well and will target basin centred gas in the Permian sandstones.

The properties of the reservoir have successfully met certain criteria and a lateral section of up to 1,500 metres will now be drilled. Fracture stimulation and testing of the well will then follow.

The gross drill cost estimate is approximately \$15 million with Planet Gas' 12.5% interest free carried by joint venture partners Senex Energy Limited and Origin Energy Limited.

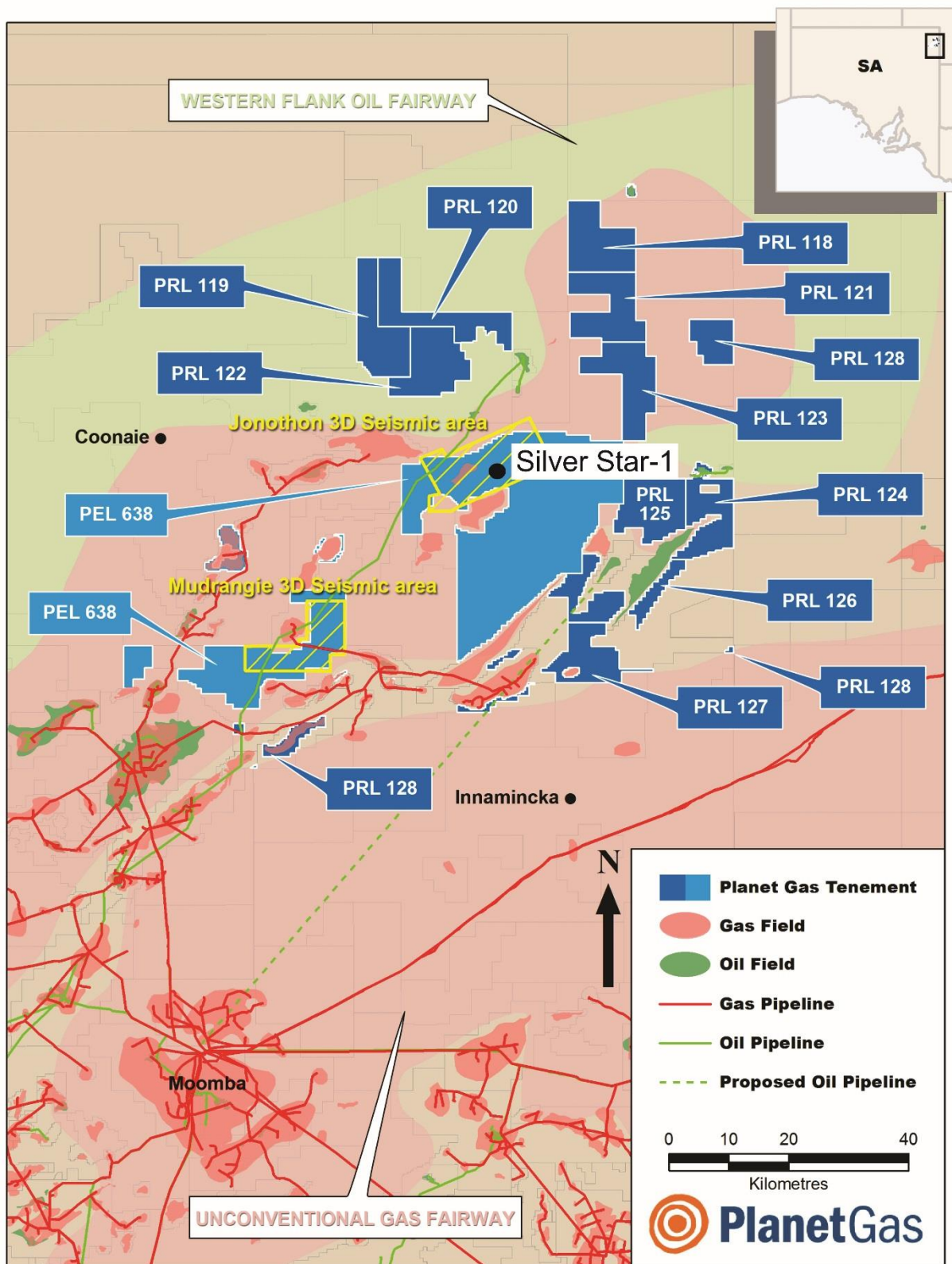


Figure 1: Location of Silver Star-1 Exploration Well
